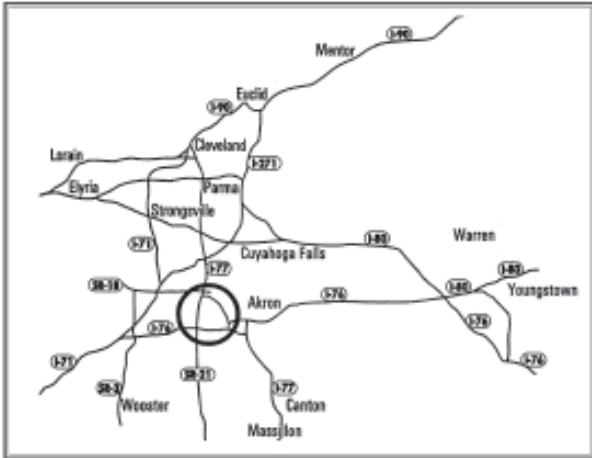


Getting to AVREC
