

Diagnostic Imaging Services

Georgia Veterinary Specialists is pleased to add Diagnostic Imaging Services to the specialties practiced at our facility. With the addition of Gustavo Sepulveda, DVM, DACVR to our staff, we are able to enhance our ability to perform in-depth diagnostic studies.

Included among the many imaging and diagnostic services we offer are the following:

- **Ultrasound** allows visualization and examination of many body organs and systems. Since ultrasonography is non-invasive, sedation is rarely necessary for the procedure to be performed. Biopsies of many internal structures may also be performed with the use of ultrasound.
- **CT Imaging** allows visualization of different parts of the body with great detail. It is particularly useful in aiding the diagnosis of nasal disease, middle/inner ear disease, neurologic disease and certain bone disorders. In addition chest and abdomen CT examination are helpful in diagnosing certain problems which are difficult to diagnose with routine radiology.
- **Radiographic Interpretation** is offered to allow for additional analysis of a diagnostic image. Radiographs can be mailed, dropped off or emailed to our facility and an oral or formal written report format can be requested based on your needs.
- **Outpatient Ultrasound** is a service offered in order to assist veterinarians in the Atlanta area in cases where an abdominal U/S is necessary. An abdominal ultrasound is performed and the patient is sent back to your clinic with the ultrasound images and a full written report. Appointments can usually be made within 24 hours on weekdays.
