Our emergency and critical care center is staffed with dedicated, highly trained veterinarians and experienced, knowledgeable technicians. The specialists on staff at GVS stand by ready to assist the emergency doctors after hours and on weekends. This service ensures that all pets receive prompt and quality emergency care whenever the need arises.

The intensive care unit at GVS offers the most advanced monitors and equipment to care for seriously ill or injured pets. The unit was designed specifically for the comfort and safety of our patients, and is fully equipped to handle any emergency situation. The specialized equipment at GVS includes a heated oxygen therapy cage, ECG capabilities, blood pressure monitors, pulse oximetry and blood gas analysis. We also have an in-house laboratory to expedite blood work or lab testing. Patients admitted to our intensive care unit receive 24-hour observation and monitoring.

Assisting our emergency doctors in both emergency and critical care is our Intern Class of 2005. Interns at GVS are licensed doctors of veterinary medicine who spend a year rotating through the various specialties offered at our facility.

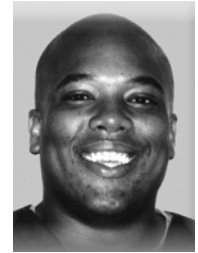
